Eastern Caribbean Ports of Call

St. Thomas, U.S. Virgin Islands

The lively port of Charlotte Amalie wins the prize for Caribbean shopping variety and thrills. Cameras, jewelry, watches, perfumes and liquors are all here. The US Virgin Islands is outside the U.S. Custom Zone. A special customs exemption of \$1200 for each person traveling to this U.S. Territory is allowed. Many items are individually exempt. Most cruise passengers seem to visit the beaches in the morning and shop in the afternoon. Why don't you consider shopping as soon as you disembark, reboard the ship laden with your purchases for a restful lunch, and then head out to sightsee or visit a sunny beach? Magens Bay Beach is considered one of the most beautiful beaches in the world. Guided tours will take you up winding hills and along mountainous roadways where it's guaranteed each breathtaking panorama is more dramatic than the one before. A particularly famous stop is Drake's Seat — the vantage point where Sir Francis Drake himself used to sit and observe his fleet.

Grand Turk, Turks & Caicos

The beautiful Turks and Caicos Islands are situated 575 miles southeast of Miami. Covering 193 square miles of the Atlantic Ocean, the islands have the third largest coral reef system and the best tropical beaches in the world, making this a premier beach, diving and snorkeling destination and an ideal location for romance, family vacations, ecotourism and adventure seekers. Grand Turk is the capital island of the Turks and Caicos. Cockburn town is the center piece of the island with a wonderful selection of historical buildings and a rustic charm that is unforgettable. Holland America was the first line to call at the new \$40 million, 13-Acre Grand Turk Cruise Center. This complex has an 800-foot pristine white-sand beach, a swimming pool, cabanas, retail shops and a Margaritaville bar and

restaurant, owned by singer Jimmy Buffet. Sunning on one of the superb beaches, shore excursions visiting island attractions, horseback riding, kayaking, and "snuba" are just some of the activities popular on this relatively undiscovered pearl.

San Juan, Puerto Rico

Picturesque Old San Juan sits on a bluff overlooking the Atlantic to the north, and the bay southwards. Dominated by the huge El Morro Fortress, this walled fortified area, now a major historical landmark, was founded in 1510. Old San Juan is compactly sized, quick to get around on foot. If your energy runs out take the free trolley bus that runs between tourist spots. Take time to stroll along the narrow cobbled streets and investigate the brightly colored houses, chic boutiques, and go to the interesting museums. The *Cathedral de San Juan* was built in 1592, on the site of the previous cathedral which had been destroyed. This neoclassical structure holds the bones of Ponce de Leon, a famous Spanish seaman, and the first governor of Puerto Rico. Outside the city, visit the *Bacardi Rum Distillery*. There's a free guided tour and trolley ride. After learning about the origins of rum enjoy a tippie or two.

Half Moon Cay – The HAL Private Island Paradise

Voted by cruise ship passengers the best private island in the Caribbean, Half Moon Cay offers everything you need for a day of relaxation and/or play: a two-mile crescent of perfect beach; an interior lagoon; beachside lounge chairs and tiki bars; private beachside cabanas with showers, misters and butlers available for rent; all manner of watersports and activities including horseback riding by land and sea, deep-sea or flats fishing, the stingray adventure, snorkeling, and a children's aqua park. Local handicrafts are available in the island plaza, and a complete barbeque lunch is served during your island stay. Don't feel like a beach day? Stay onboard
